Certa is a national awarding organisation and a QAA-licensed Access Validating Agency. We have worked in collaboration with curriculum specialists in Further and Higher Education to develop a Regional Access to HE Diploma in Contemporary Dance.

Access to HE Diplomas are designed to provide a route into Higher Education for adults with a commitment to studying, and who have the ability to benefit from Higher Education, but have not previously been in a position to do so.

Organisations who wish to deliver this Diploma for the first time will be supported through the process by our Access to HE Team.

Progression Routes:

Students progress to HE dance or dance related programmes of study within the university and conservatoire sectors. Typically, students successfully audition for conservatoire style training at HE institutions including Northern School of Contemporary Dance, Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance, London Contemporary Dance School, Rambert School of Ballet and Contemporary Dance, Scottish School of Contemporary Dance and London Studio Centre. These are established progression routes and are testament to the reputation of Access to HE Diploma programme and the standard of the students who complete it.
